In Ohio, schools are required to screen students for developmental delays that may impact your child's ability to succeed in school.

All incoming kindergarten students will be screened in the following areas:

- Basic academic skills (pre-reading and math)
- Gross motor skills
- Fine motor skills
- Hearing and Vision
- Speech

Kindergarten Screening is a quick snapshot of your child's developmental skills prior to entering kindergarten. The information gained from the screening process will help us develop an educational plan that addresses your child's unique strengths or needs.

Registration Requirements

The parent or legal guardian will need to bring the following documents to your child's Kindergarten Screening and registration appointment:

- A certified copy of your child's birth certificate (obtained from the health department in the city or county where your child was born).
- The parent or legal guardian must provide a **photo ID.**
- **■** Proof of Residency
 - A recent bill pertaining to your place of residence such as a utility bill.
 - A copy of your lease or a rental receipt
 - OR you can complete the "Proof of Residency Form" available at registration
- **Custody papers** if applicable.
- Age Eligibility:

To be eligible for kindergarten your child must be five on or prior to August 1, 2018.

Physical and Immunization Requirements



- A physical examination is required prior to the first day of kindergarten. Physical examinations can be obtained through your family doctor, The Little Clinic, or Miami County Public Health. Any well child visit dated August 14th 2017 to the current day is valid as the Kindergarten physical. Evidence of the physical can be provided on our Piqua City School Physical Form or you can provide a print-out with a "review of systems" from your child's office or clinic visit.
- Your child must be current with all immunization requirements including kindergarten booster shots. Please bring a copy of your child's immunization record to Kindergarten Screening and Registration!

If your child has medical needs or will need to take medication at school please be sure to talk to the nurse.
