All you have to do is READ! Track the minutes you read each day on the Summer Reading Log attached, or record electronically on our district website! Turn in your Summer Reading Log to your school by Friday, August 25th to be eligible for rewards and your chance to win fun prizes!

Ways to earn book bucks include:

*For every 100 minutes read you earn 1 “Book Buck”

*Participation in the Public Library Summer Reading Program = 1 Book Buck per trip to the Library. The Children’s Department will track your participation and share this information with the school!

*Participation in a ‘Reading with the Mayor’ session = 1 Book Buck (See attached flyer)
Every “Book Buck” earned equals a chance to win some great prizes such as electronics, toys, games, books and more!!!!
