Health	.5 credit
Financial Literacy	.5 credit
Fine Art (Art, Band, Choir)	1 credit
Elective Credits	6 credits

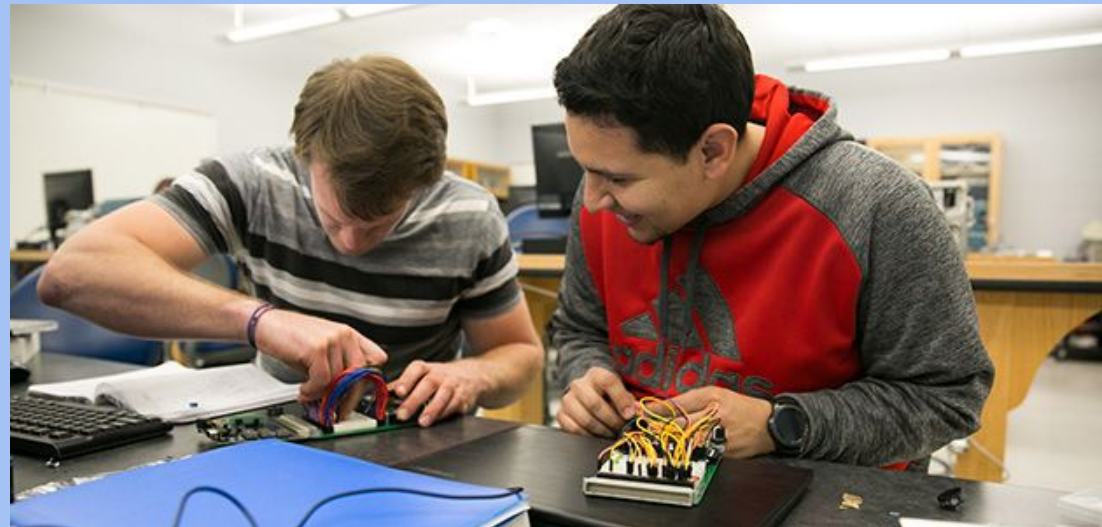
