

Hello K-3 PCS Parents,

This e-mail is confirmation that your child is registered for the Piqua City Schools remote learning option for the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year. If you did not sign your child up for remote learning or no longer wish for your child to participate in the remote learning option, we will be happy to make those corrections. Now that we have student names for the remote learning option, we are able to finalize registrations and get more information out to parents. We will be hosting a parent meeting at each school that will be announced by the building principals. At that meeting, we will have computer distribution for those that need them and log on information for all students to access the remote learning curriculum. We will also have information about breakfast/lunch needs/distribution while your child is learning at home through the remote learning option.

If you haven't already done so, please visit our website at [www.piqua.org](http://www.piqua.org) and click on the Parent OneView Portal at the top right-hand side of the screen to complete and update all registration forms. We will need these to be finished prior to issuing computers and registering students for their remote learning classes.



Here are some general reminders about the K-3 Remote Learning Option.

As a reminder, remote learning is an online option that will keep your child enrolled in the Piqua City Schools but provide instruction at home through a digital platform through the use of a computer.

K-3 students will use Schools PLP. Just as with an in-person school setting, daily course work will be completed by each student. Students will be provided with video lessons, demonstrations, reading (or listening), practice, application, extension, reinforcement, and assessments all through the Schools PLP remote learning system. Students will engage in lessons each day with reading, writing, math, social studies, and science. Parents may select art

and music if they wish for their child as well. Art and music are optional and are not required. More information about that will be shared at the parent meeting.

It's important to note that in order for students to earn grades and pass on to the next grade level, the State requires that remote learning students log on and complete timely assignments each day. It will be important for students to have a schedule, space, and support at home that will allow them to focus and engage in their independent work daily.

Piqua City Schools will provide a teacher liaison who will help monitor student attendance, progress, and successful completion of lessons delivered through the Schools PLP system. This teacher will also be able to assist parents and students with questions about lessons provided through the Schools PLP.
