What is Remote Learning with Odysseyware?

Odysseyware is:

- Based on Standards and Grade-Level Content
- Self-paced
- Made up of articles, reading, videos and simulations
- Aligned with the standards and content of the in-person classroom

Odysseyware is:

- Graded by PCIS staff- who will communicate with students in Odysseyware
- Designed to allow for students to move at their pace
- Able to be completed on any day of the week, at any time

Odysseyware does not/is not:

- The same type of learning that was conducted last spring
- Connected with the classroom teachers through Google Meets, Skype, etc., for assistance
- Following the exact same sequence as in-person learning

- You will receive these today- please keep them in case you can't remember them!


When Can I Begin my Work?
