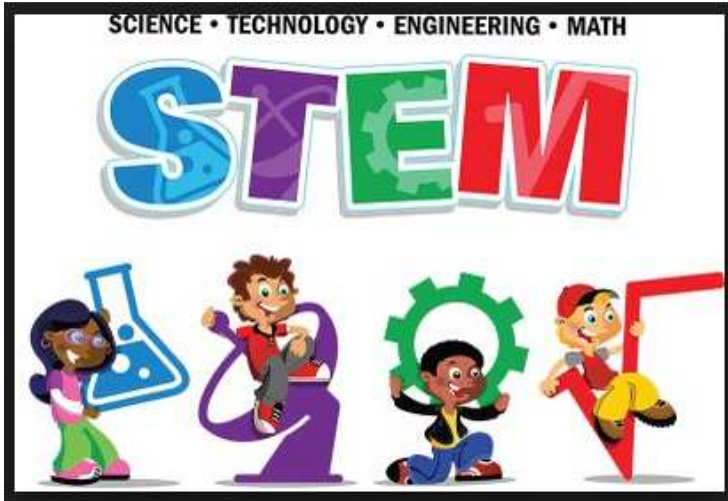




Piqua City Schools Summer Activities

Where: Washington Primary

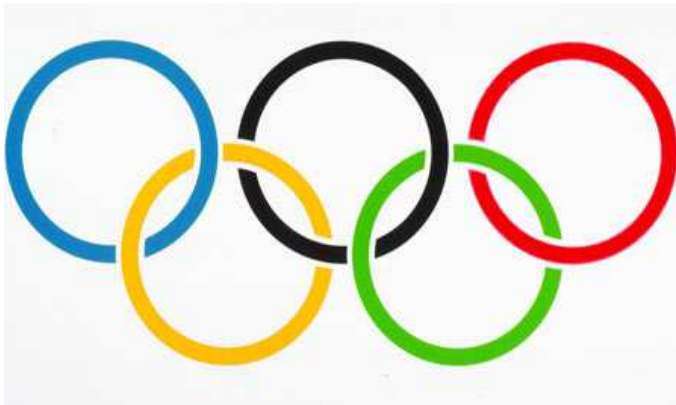
When: June 6-9th & 13-16th
