### A CELEBRATION OF EDUCATION

The Piqua Education Foundation (PEF) recognized Piqua High School graduates at the Celebration of Education Reception held on May 30th in conjunction with Class Night. This reception is a chance for students to interact with each other and PEF donors while being recognized for their academic achievements.

The Piqua Education Foundation was created over 30 years ago in order to enhance the educational opportunities for Piqua City Schools students, graduates and staff. The endowment fund has done exactly that, by awarding college scholarships for PHS graduates and funding educational grants for Piqua City Schools teachers and staff.

This year PEF is extremely proud to award over \$300,000.00 to nearly 150 students! It is important to note that for a district our size, it is extremely rare to be able to offer so much financial support to our families and students to continue their education after their high school years. The Celebration of Education also featured 10 Piqua Promise scholarships. Promise Scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors who plan to attend Edison State Community College. Piqua Promise scholarships of \$2,500.00 each were awarded to 10 graduating seniors. These 10 scholarships were matched by Edison State Community College with an additional \$2,500.00 each. This provides a full year tuition to Edison for those ten students. These Piqua Promise scholarships are renewable for a second year as well, as long as academic requirements are met. The long term goal of the Piqua Promise is remove financial barriers that can limit access to post secondary education, be it a technical school, vocational school or a more traditional 2 or 4 year college.

## THE LUNDGARD FOUNDATIONS 2018

The Lundgard Foundation and the Lundgard Charitable Trust recently granted special grants to the Piqua Education Foundation and the Lehman High School Foundation for the 2018 graduates. Since college scholarships were first presented to Piqua area students in 1990, more than \$1,500,000 in scholarships have been awarded. This year an extra \$20,000 was granted so the 2018 graduates can be awarded up to an additional \$500 to recognize this important milestone. The goal of these special awards is to give monetary assistance to the brightest and most deserving students who are pursuing training and education beyond high school. In addition to the awards made to graduating seniors the Lundgard scholorships also provide the schools with funds for students in their second, third and fourth years of study.

The original Lundgard Foundation was established in 1990 by Ruth Lundgard, wife of Niels Lundgard, co-founder of Aerovent Fan. Lundgard came to the United States from Denmark in 1907. His wife Ruth, also from Denmark, joined him in 1949. Although Mr. Lundgard died in 1973, Mrs. Lundgard remained active in the affairs of the Company until the time it was sold in 1989. The second Lundgard Charitable was created in 2002 at the death of Mrs. Lundgard. She was a kind and generous supporter of education with a keen interest in quality education and the plans put in place even after her death continue doing good works.

The generosity of the Lundgards will continue to primarily benefit the persons living in the Piqua area that has exceeded over \$8,000,000 to date for charitable, religious, scientific, literary and education purposes.
